Please be advised that the recently-issued rejection letters were intended to formally notify applicants of **unsuccessful applications for last year's Municipal Capital Works program only**. A number of these applications were subsequently approved under other programs, such as Multi-Year Capital Works and the Small Communities Fund.

If you have received a rejection letter for a project that had previously received an approval letter, that project has NOT been cancelled. The purpose of the letters was to clarify the status of any outstanding applications from last year to ensure applicants were aware of which ones might need to be re-submitted under the current call for applications.
